## **CHAPTER – 1**

Nouns



## A *noun* is a word that names persons, animals, places and things.

## •There are different types of nouns:

- A proper noun is the name of a particular person, thing or place.
- **Examples:** Anuja, Ravi, Sunday, January, the Eiffel Tower
- <u>A common noun</u> is used to refer to people, places or things in general.
- **Examples:** girl, man, day, month, city, building

A collective noun refers to a group of a particular animal, bird, thing or people.

**Examples:** a pride of lions, a herd of swans, a galaxy of stars, an army of soldiers

A possessive noun describes who owns a particular thing.

**Examples:** the girl's dress, Ravi's room, the lion's mane

 <u>A concrete noun</u> refers to an object that can be experienced through at least one of our five senses.
<u>Example:</u> The birds' feathers were of glorious colours

• <u>An Abstract noun</u> that you **cannot** touch, smell, see or hear.

**Example:** We saw a pride of lions, who lay quietly in the forest.
